**AMENDMENT OF CERTIFICATION**

Pursuant to section 2422.1 of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Labor Relations Authority, a petition was filed seeking to amend the certification granted to the American Federation of Government Employees, AFL-CIO, Local 3013, on September 7, 1979, in Case No. 1-RO-10, as the exclusive representative for certain employees of the U.S. Department of Defense, National Guard Bureau, Veterans and Emergency Management Military Bureau, Maine National Guard. The petition sought to change the designation of the exclusive representative for this existing bargaining unit from the American Federation of Government Employees, AFL-CIO, Local 3013 to the Association of Civilian Technicians.

On July 2, 1999, I issued a Decision and Order on the Petition finding that the certification may be amended as requested.


The parties waived their right to file an Application for Review. Pursuant to the authority vested in me as Regional Director,

I ORDER that the certification granted to the American Federation of Government Employees, AFL-CIO, Local 3013 on September 7, 1979, in Case No. 1-RO-10, as the exclusive representative of the following unit of employees:

INCLUDED: All Wage Grade and General Schedule civilian employees at all locations of the Maine Air National Guard, United States Department of Defense.

EXCLUDED: Professional employees, employees engaged in personnel work in other than a purely clerical capacity; confidential employees, management officials, and supervisors; and employees described in 5 U.S.C §7112 (b) (2), (3), (4), (6) and (7).

be amended by changing the designation of the exclusive representative from the American Federation of Government Employees, AFL-CIO, Local 3013 to the Association of Civilian Technicians.
