Responsibilities in this existing vacant position include, but are not limited to:

- provide empty containers for cones of yarn
- identify yarn and/or feeder stock (POY), take yarn to winders and/or air texturing equipment
- label cones on finished yarn, doff and stack neatly into tubs or other containers
- identify when machine needs more yarn or POY and fill as needed, fill tubs with appropriate yarn
- inspect yarn for quality
- operate forklift and power and manual jacks
- perform custodial cleaning, as needed
- remove and deliver finished yarn to scales, weigh and send to appropriate department
- remove full tubs of waste from cone stripping area and replace with empty ones
- help keep cone stripping area straight and clean
- complete operational tickets
- cross train to operate air texturizing machines and SSM winders
- clean machinery and work area
- perform miscellaneous duties as necessary
- follow safe work practices
- participate in LEAN, safety, and other sustainability initiatives
- maintain environmental standards and support ISO 14001 initiatives
