

Since October 2004, the Maine Military Funeral Honor Program has performed 3111 Military Funerals for the Veterans of Maine. According to the Maine Veteran's Administration, Maine will lose nearly 4000 Veterans (all branches) per year through the year 2010. Retirees are welcome to participate in providing Military Funeral Honors for Maine's Veterans. The rendering of Military Funeral Honors is a way to show our Nation's deep gratitude to those who, in times of war and peace, have faithfully defended our country. Funds are available to compensate certain categories of retirees and buglers. When requested, Retirees, in class A uniform will receive a per day stipend, (whether training or performing a Military Funeral. This stipend is intended to offset the cost of gasoline, meal and other authorized expenses. To perform Military Funerals you will need to train with the current members of the team. This would be a 4 hour, hands on session. I will not put you on

the spot. You will not be asked to present a flag to the next of kin until you are comfortable. If you have any questions please contact me at the above numbers or stop by my office here at the Augusta Armory.

Only person to receive a stipend are those requested to be party of the funeral party by Mr. Norwood and are qualified.



Greetings MeARNG Retirees.

I have received many e-mails concerning proposed or possible cuts in military retirees medical benefits. I am pretty sure that the current administration is looking for ways to save funds in this area.

Most concerns I have seen surround Tricare-For Life. As you know you must be 65 years old and on medicare and pay part A and B. Tricare for Life is the second payer. As it stands now we pay nothing for it. Our military ID card is our ticket for this.

I have heard that the Congressional Budget Office has made overtures to make us pay co-pays, annual fees etc.

HEY we all need to be concerned NOW. Even if you are a gray area retiree, because before you know it you will be 60 drawing retirement and than 65 eligible for Tricare-for Life. REMEMBER we were promised free medical care for life for our serving 20 years or more.

SO here is what I and many others recommend. Write to our senators and representatives, tell them not to cut the military retiree medical benefits. As you must know States and the US government are looking everywhere to generate savings to be spent elsewhere.
